
The Cinque Terre & Tuscany


A Sailing Adventure in a South Pacific Paradise

In ages past Fijians were feared all across Melanesian Pacific for their ferocious warriors and fearsome battle cries, but luckily today their friendliness and hospitality are what is legendary.

Fiji is known for its large pelagic fish, and stunning soft corals. Drift dives are the norm, and we also spend time throughout the trip in sheltered lagoons and

coral gardens where the reefs shelter the smaller critters. The dive sites in this region vary from steep walls and pinnacles to sandy slopes with coral gardens where you can easily see manta and eagle rays as well as schools of unicorn fish & tuna. Colourful butterfly fish species graze over the reef and huge potato grouper are also to be found here. Smaller creatures such as blue ribbon eels, hawk fish and leaf fish give macro lovers something to watch out for too. But the real draw for the region is the sheer variety of sharks and rays that will be seen - white tips, black tips, silver tips, grey reef and bull sharks mix in with hammerheads, whale and tiger sharks. This is one elasmobranch soup you'll be pleased to see!

Our expedition vessel is the luxury yacht NAI'A, a 120' motor-sailer, hosting 18 guests in 9 private air-conditioned staterooms with an experienced crew of 10.


Exotic Bali and the Komodo Islands National Park

The Indonesian Archipelago has over 17,500 islands... and almost 11,000 are uninhabited! During our journey we'll sail past some of the most dramatic volcanic islands in the world as we explore the fabled Komodo Islands, with LOTS of stops for diving!

Our adventure begins with an overnight in exotic and bustling Denpasar, Bali before boarding a flight to the island of Flores, far to the east. There we'll board the sailing-motor vessel Komodo Dancer, a 98 ft long and 30 ft wide two-masted Phinisi Bugis Schooner with 3 decks. Constructed utilizing traditional methods it offers all the modern amenities, safety and comfort of a world class live aboard dive vessel. The Komodo

do Dancer boasts a crew of 14 to take care of our group of 14, so we can expect to be pampered and well fed throughout our voyage.

The Komodo Islands National Park offers truly legendary diving, with over 1000 species of fish and nearly 300 species of coral. The remote Komodo region has everything from majestic mantas, schooling jacks, barracudas, oceanic white tip sharks and tuna to pigmy seahorses, nudibranchs, ghost pipefish, and crustaceans galore. Scuba divers often encounter new, unknown species while diving in the Komodo Marine Park. We'll also dive at the islands of Satonda, Gilli Banta, Nusa Kode, Lankgoi, Batu Moncho, Pasir Putih and Lawah Darat. While at Komodo we'll venture ashore to seek out the fearsome Komodo Dragons, the world's largest lizard at 10' long and over 400 lbs!


Costa Rica – Osa Peninsula
